

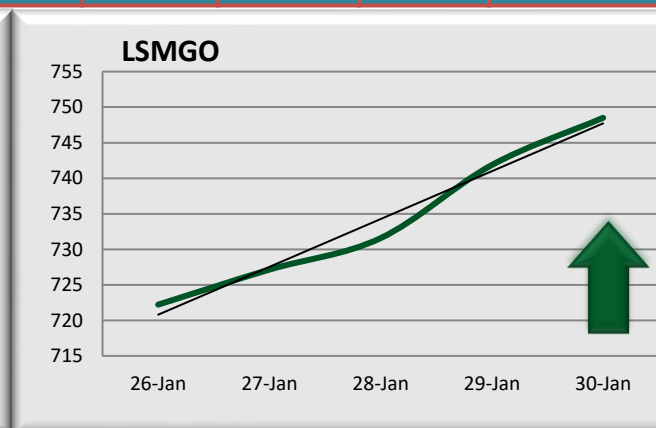
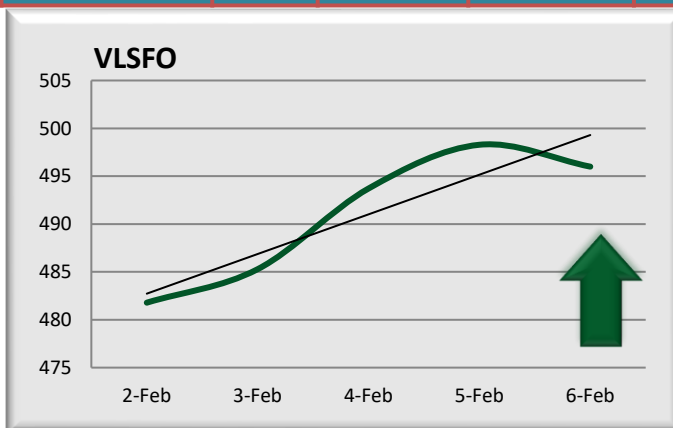


Top stories of the week

➤ China's Nantong CIMC Sinopacific Offshore & Engineering recently secured three vital new orders for specialized liquefied natural gas bunkering vessels, comprised of two 20,000-cubic-meter units and one 18,900-cubic-meter ship. This brings their total backlog for these specific designs to thirteen vessels, with construction on the smaller variant starting later this year. This commercial success reflects a broader industry trend noted by classification society DNV, which reports that the rapidly expanding global LNG-fueled fleet will grow by over six hundred ships by 2030, creating urgent requirements for expanded supply infrastructure beyond the sixty-four bunkering vessels currently in active operation globally today.

➤ The maritime sector is exploring nuclear propulsion, a topic dominating a recent Core Power summit in Washington where key stakeholders debated pathways for commercial deployment. Experts like Chris Wiernicki and Mikal Boe argued that while nuclear power offers long-term fuel stability and extended range, realizing this potential fully demands aligned regulatory frameworks, safety protocols, and successful early demonstration projects. Participants suggested floating nuclear port power plants could serve as initial test cases to overcome hesitation, while globally the International Maritime Organization has officially commenced work on critical safety guidelines to eventually facilitate this complex but highly promising energy transition.
